BURIAL POLICY

Vault Requirements

According to the Milford City code, a standard burial vault made of concrete or fiberglass must be used for all burials, with exception of cremation burials. Cremation burials must be in a solid container, such as plastic or wood, but concrete or fiberglass is not required.

Prior Notice Requirement

To properly prepare the gravesite for interment, a minimum of two full business days' notice must be given prior to the burial. In extreme weather conditions and during multiple overlapping requests additional time may be required to prepare the grave for burial. Always contact the city office when scheduling a burial. Failure to give two full business days' notice will result in additional fees. (See Cemetery Fee Schedule https://www.milfordcityutah.com/index.php/1/cemetery).

Days Burials Are Not Allowed

The cemetery does not perform burials or schedule funerals on the following holidays or the observance thereof by Milford City:

- 1. New Year's Day
- 2. Friday before Memorial Day
- 3. Saturday before Memorial Day
- 4. Sunday before Memorial Day
- 5. Memorial Day
- 6. Independence Day
- 7. Pioneer Day (July 24)
- 8. Veterans Day
- 9. Thanksgiving Day
- 10. Day after Thanksgiving
- 11. Christmas Eve
- 12. Christmas Day

Holidays that Milford City Cemetery will perform burials and schedule funerals – Holiday Rates apply for the opening and closing:

- 1. Human Rights Day 3rd Monday in January
- 2. President's Day 3rd Monday in February
- 3. Juneteenth If June 19th falls on a Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, the holiday is observed on the preceding Monday; if June 19th falls on a Saturday or Sunday, it is observed on the following Monday
- 4. Labor Day 1st Monday in September
- 5. Harvest Day 1st Monday of the Deer Hunt in October
